Main idea | 1



The Project is **pioneering** as it assumes the **innovative use of sport** for social inclusion and integration of people with physical and visual disabilities (PwD) with able-bodied (AbP) people.

The main idea is to go beyond the current scheme of action in the field of inclusion of people with disabilities in sport and perhaps initiate a completely new trend in sport.

We plan to organize the competitions in such a way that able-bodied and people with disabilities can first integrate and adapt during common trainings, and then compete together.



Main idea | 2



Many years of experience confirm that PwD and AbP can play sports together at the recreational level (in Poland there have been such attempts at Sitting-Volleyball, Goalball and Boccia). We want to expand the range of these sports with other disciplines. Moreover, to some sports (Volleyball, Table tennis, Swimming, Archery) we are going to invite ablebodied athletes who practice them.

In order to guarantee an appropriate level of competition and to motivate participants to take part in this event, we are going to organize regular sport competitions only for people with disabilities.



Organization



The event will take place from Saturday, June 17th to Friday, June 23rd, 2023, in Wągrowiec.

Participation in the event is **FREE OF CHARGE** for participants. The European Union covers all the costs, except for **travel** to / from Wągrowiec.


A total of about 500 people will take part in Dis+Abled Games, including able-bodied and disabled athletes from at least 10 European countries.










Organizational scheme


